Labor Day Weekend Reminders on the Pool and Trash Pickup

City Hall will be closed on Monday, Sept. 2, for the Labor Day holiday, reopening at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 3. The Library also will be closed on Monday.

Reminders for the holiday weekend:

-- This is the final opportunity for public use of the Flowers Park pool. Hours are noon to 7 p.m. Saturday, 2 to 6 p.m. Sunday and 1 to 7 p.m. Monday. Swimming will be available only for dogs on Saturday, Sept. 7 (see below), then the pool will close for cleaning and winterization, reopening next May.

-- Trash pickup for next week will be moved back one day. Tuesday's pickup will be on Wednesday, and Wednesday's pickup will be on Thursday.

LifeLine Animal Project Says Need for Foster Caregivers Is Great

LifeLine Animal Project, which will bring dogs for adoption to the City's Splish Splash Doggie Bash on Saturday, Sept. 7, says there is an urgent need to place homeless pets with foster caregivers. The shelter says it took in 870 animals in July, an increase of 164 over last July.

LifeLine will hold a grand opening on Oct. 5 for a new [Community Animal Center](#) that will allow an increase in capacity.
