We appreciate your patience as the City of Doraville closed Jess Norman Way in order to replace deteriorated stormwater infrastructure under Jess Norman Way and through adjacent properties. The project is complete and the street is open. The contractor will be removing the detour signs in the next few days. It is planned that the complete street will receive a form of resurfacing as part of the SPLOST capital improvement budget. A date certain for this resurfacing will be forthcoming as we map out final plans for the funds to be received through SPLOST.

Although all City of Doraville offices will be closed on Monday, January 21, 2019 in observance of MLK day, regular trash, recyclables, and bagged yard waste collection will remain on its regular schedule.

Some important notes to remember about trash pickup are:

- Place items and carts at the curb for collection, by 6:30 a.m. on the day of collection, but no sooner than the day before. Collections start at 7:00 a.m. and don’t want to miss you.
- Empty carts/bins are to be removed from the curbside by the end of collection day.
- Do not mix yard waste with other household trash.
- Do not place items or carts in the street, on storm drains, around mailboxes, fences or utility poles, under utility wires or where they will interfere with traffic visibility.

Leaf Vacuum Collection Will End Friday, February 1, 2019



The City of Doraville Leaf Collection Program will be coming to an end for the season on Friday, February 1, 2019. After February 1, 2019, curb will **NO LONGER** be serviced for the season, and all leaves must be bagged in paper biodegradable yard waste bags. Yard waste pickup will continue in conjunction with the regular sanitation collection schedule, which is serviced by Advanced Disposal.

Through January, please avoid:

- Placing leaf piles in the street
- Placing tree limbs, sticks, or other debris in the leaf piles
- Blocking access to leaf piles by parking cars on or in front of leaf piles
- Placing leaves in plastic bags – **Leaves placed in plastic bags will not be collected**
- Mixing dirt with leaves – **Bags filled with dirt will not be collected**
