CITYWIDE CLEANUP DAY SET FOR APRIL 13

Let's Do Our Part!



Doraville's Spring Citywide Cleanup Day will take place from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, April 13, at the Old Doraville Police Station parking lot, 3760 Park Avenue. It's an opportunity for residents to dispose of items that don't fit into the regular trash or would require an appointment for pickup. The City will collect bulk items, electronics, cardboard boxes and scrap metals.

Accepted bulk items: refrigerators (Freon and antifreeze removed), toilets (tank removed from bowl), couches, mattresses, loveseats, TVs, computers, children's toys, furniture, lawn mowers (no gasoline), grills (no propane), patio furniture, exercise equipment, bicycles.

Not accepted: hazardous household materials, construction debris, fences, cement bathtubs, wood, carpet, siding, windowpanes, metal sheds, roofing, flooring, cupboards, paint, tires.

Reminder: Change in Yard Waste Collection Service Schedule

Starting the week of April 8, the City will collect bagged yard waste on each customer's regular recycling and garbage collection day. The change in service will allow residents to put out everything for pickup on the same day. Garbage, recycling and yard waste must

be in appropriate containers and placed at the curb for collection by 6:30 a.m.

Yard waste must be in brown paper bags or customer-owned receptacles weighing no more than 50 pounds and must be clearly marked "Yard Waste."

Please be mindful that the leaf vacuum truck, allowing for raking leaves to the curb for pickup, ended for the season on Jan. 31. All leaves must be bagged for pickup until next season.
