## Reminders: Citywide Cleanup Day, Yard Waste Collection, Tax Day

- Doraville's Spring Citywide Cleanup Day will take place from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, April 13, at the Old Doraville Police Station parking lot, 3760 Park Avenue. Residents will be able to dispose of items that do not fit into the regular trash or would require an appointment for pickup. The City will collect bulk items, electronics, cardboard boxes and scrap metals. For more information: (770) 451-8745.
  - The City is now collecting bagged yard waste on each customer's regular recycling and garbage collection day. Garbage, recycling and yard waste must be in appropriate containers and placed at the curb for collection by 6:30 a.m. Yard waste must be in brown paper bags or customer-owned receptacles weighing no more than 50 pounds and clearly marked "Yard Waste."
  - Monday, April 15, is Tax Day, the day that individual income tax returns are due to the federal government for the 2018 tax year. There is no grace day this year. If you request and receive an extension, your deadline will be Oct. 15.
