



City of Doraville is Participating in the PDK Airport Master Plan Development Public Open House & Additional Information

The DeKalb Peachtree Airport Master Plan has embarked upon a planning process that will provide a 20-year horizon of short, intermediate, and long-term development goals for the airport. The objective of the Airport Master Plan is to provide the framework needed to guide future airport development that will satisfy aviation demand while considering potential environmental and socioeconomic issues. The Plan will be based on aviation activity forecasts and will be developed through a combination of professional evaluations and public involvement.



Mayor Donna Pittman has appointed **Mr. Ronald “Lee” Wiggins**, City resident of the Winters Chapel area, and **Councilmember Robert Patrick** to serve on the Airport’s Citizen Advisory Committee. Also, serving directly in the planning process are the Mayor’s appointments to the Intergovernmental Coordinating Committee, City staff members **Enrique Bascunana, Director of Community Development** and **Larry King, Director of Public Works**.

Although the Airport sits within the City of Chamblee, in multiple ways Doraville is a major stakeholder; from the flight patterns that impact Doraville to the jobs and economic impact the Airport provides to our City.
